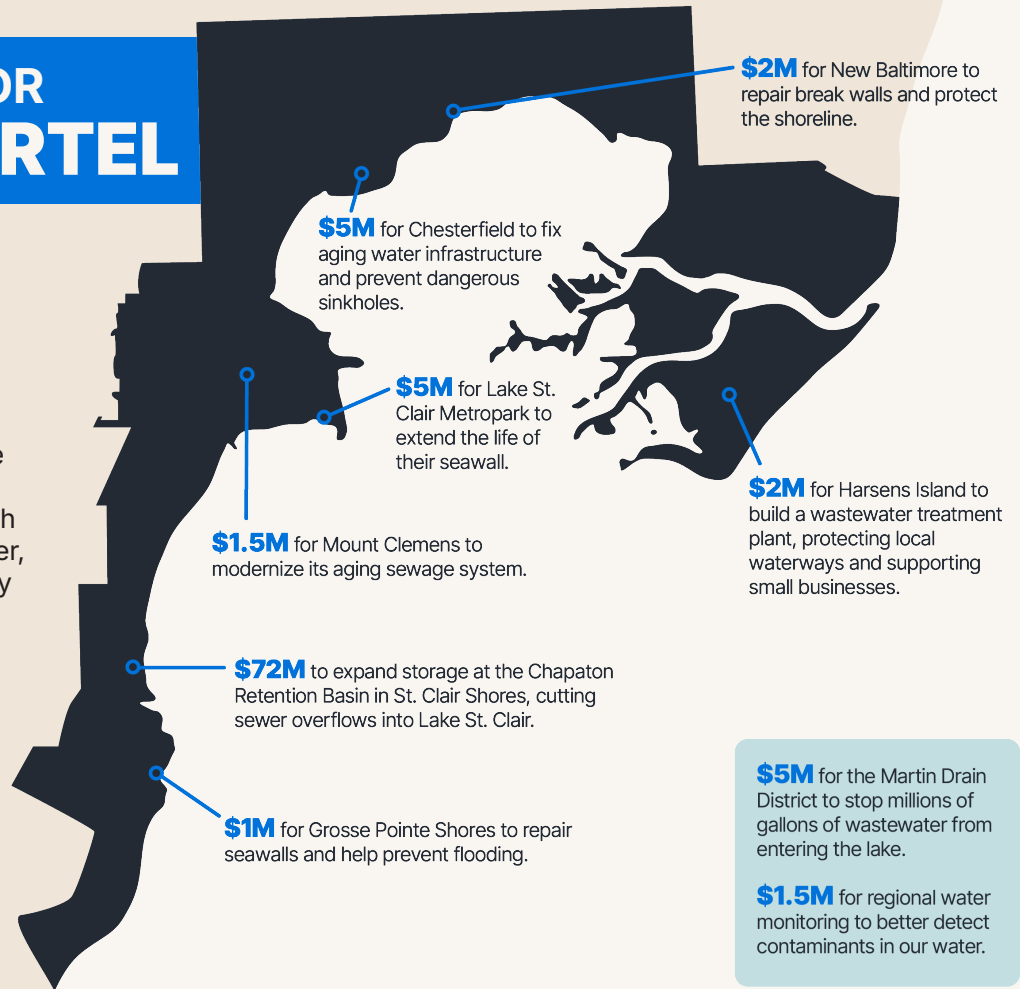

Fighting to Protect Lake St. Clair

Thanks to these investments, Selfridge has been awarded a new refueling mission and a new fighter mission, safeguarding the base's future — while protecting the over \$850 million in annual economic activity Selfridge generates.

MACOMB COUNTY JAIL'S NEW MENTAL HEALTH INTAKE

Championed funding for a new central intake and mental health unit at the Macomb County Jail — an investment that will help provide better mental and physical health outcomes for those who come in contact with the criminal justice system. Once complete, the new jail is set to become a national model on how to keep our communities safe, while ensuring the needs of our most vulnerable are met.

NEW FIRE TRUCK FOR MOUNT CLEMENS

Successfully advocated for the funding Mount Clemens needed to purchase a new fire truck to ensure the city's firefighters have the tools and equipment they need to respond to emergencies.
